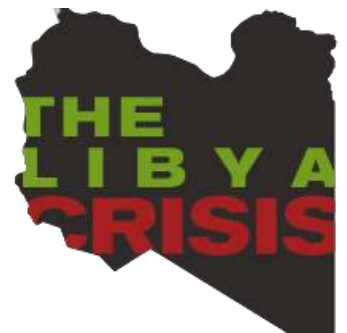

let us look at some facts regarding Gaddafi and Libya :

[1] FIRST AFRICAN SATELITE

It was Gaddafi of Libya that offered all of Africa its first revolution in modern times – connecting the entire continent by telephone, television, radio broadcasting and several other technological applications such as telemedicine and distance teaching. It began in 1992, when 45 African nations established RASCOM (Regional African Satellite Communication Organization) so that Africa would have its own satellite and slash communication costs in the continent. This was a time when phone calls to and from Africa were the most expensive in the world because of the annual US\$500 million fee pocketed by Europe for the use of its satellites like Intelsat for phone conversations, including those within the same country.

It was Gaddafi of Libya that put US\$300 million on the table; the African Development Bank added US\$50 million more and the West African Development Bank a further US\$27 million – and that's how Africa got its first communications satellite on 26 December 2007. China and Russia followed suit and shared their technology and helped launch satellites for South Africa, Nigeria, Angola, Algeria and a second African satellite was launched in July 2010.



[2] GADDAFI HELPED IN THE STRUGGLE AGAINST APARTHEID

For most Africans, Gaddafi is a generous man, known for his unselfish support for the struggle against the racist regime in South Africa having risked the wrath of the West to help the ANC both militarily and financially in the fight against apartheid. This was why Mandela, soon after his release from 27 years in jail, decided to break the UN embargo and travel to Libya on 23 October 1997. Mandela didn't mince his words when the former US president Bill Clinton said the visit was an 'unwelcome' one – 'No country can claim to be the policeman of the world and no state can dictate to another what it should do'. He added – 'Those that yesterday were friends of our enemies have the gall today to tell me not to visit my brother Gaddafi, they are advising us to be ungrateful and forget our friends of the past'.

[3] AFRICAN MONETARY FUND, AFRICAN CENTRAL & INVESTMENT BANK

The US\$30 billion frozen by Mr Obama belong to the Libyan Central Bank and had been earmarked as the Libyan contribution to three key projects which would add the finishing touches to the African Federation – the African Investment Bank in Syrte, Libya, the establishment in 2011 of the African Monetary Fund to be based in Yaounde with a US\$42 billion capital fund and the Abuja-based African Central Bank in Nigeria which when it starts printing African money will ring the death knell for the CFA franc through which Paris has been able to maintain its hold on some African countries for the last fifty years. AMF: African Monetary Fund which was planned to produce its own currency for Africa, backed by Gold standard. Interest free. It is easy to understand the French wrath against Gaddafi.

[4] LIBYA'S \$70 TRILLION BLUE GOLD - LIBYA'S PRICELESS WATER BASINS.

In Libya there are four major underground basins, the first three of which contain combined reserves of 35,000 cubic kilometres of water. These vast reserves offer almost unlimited amounts of water for the Libyan people. In the 1960s during oil exploration deep in the southern Libyan Desert, vast reservoirs of high quality water were discovered in the form of aquifers. Gaddafi, started the construction for the Phase I of the \$25 Billion "Great Man made River Project" GMR in 1984 which is a network of pipes that supplies water from the Sahara Desert in Libya. It is the world's largest irrigation project It carries more than five million cubic metres of water per day across the desert to coastal areas, vastly increasing the amount of arable land. Scientists estimate the amount of water to be equivalent to the flow of 200 years of water in the Nile River.

[5] Libya sits on one of Africa's largest oil and natural gas reserves.

[6] A few weeks before Libya was invaded, Gaddafi had decided to sell his oil to only Russia, China and India. [7] Libya's \$300 Billion Gold reserves!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!

[8] LIBYA UNDER GADDAFI GAVE AID TO AFRICAN COUNTRIES.

In 2010 Gaddafi offered to invest \$97 billion in Africa to free it from Western influence. Here is a selection of the initiatives Libya has already put in place in Africa, as well as some of the projects it is planning, explaining why the West's illegal war against Libya also is a war against Entire Africa.

CONGO: Libya has put \$65 billion into sovereign wealth funds, including one which is specifically designed to make investments in Africa. . In 2010, Libya planned to fund the building of a highway north of Congo's capital Brazzaville, where also the building of a mosque is planned.

LIBERIA: Libya has provided millions in investment projects, helping to strengthen the rule of President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf in one of Africa's most impoverished nations. Gaddafi's help includes the funding of a rubber processing factory built in Gbarnga, Bong County, a technical and vocational school for the handicapped, as well as Libyan assistance in helping Liberia tackle the food crisis and renovation for the Ducor Intercontinental Hotel.

NIGER: Libyan Prime Minister Al-Baghdadi Ali al-Mahmoudi visited Niger in August 2010 and announced the creation of a \$100 million investment fund for Niger as part of a strengthening of bilateral ties. Under earlier agreements, Libya is contributing 100 million Euros for the construction of a Trans-Sahara highway in the north of Niger.

CHAD: Gaddafi has been a key supporter of the government, which would weaken if it lost his aid revenue. Chad has been plagued by civil wars and invasions after its independence from France in 1960. After years of unrest, Gaddafi seals a peace agreement for Chad between four Chadian rebel groups and the Chadian government in 2007, which agreement was signed in Sirte. In 2010 Libya made a huge investment in Chad's National Telecom, which meant a boost of the number of the Chadian mobile phone users from 100,000 to two million. And many other countries [Mali, Mauritania, Gambia etc]

[9] AFRICAN UNION: Libya is one of the biggest contributors to the budget of the African Union. A Libyan diplomat told Reuters Libya is one of five countries -- the others are Algeria, Egypt, Nigeria and South Africa -- which cover 75 percent of the Union's budget. "Libya makes its full required contribution to AU funds. Not all countries do and that buys it influence," a senior African Union official said.

Because Gaddafi planned to free the entire African continent from the clutches of Western imperialism, USA, EU and NATO orchestrated the removal of Gaddafi.

[10] FINANCING MUSLIM CAUSES

(a) Libya Ranks No. 1 on the Human Development Index: According to the United Nations Development Programme, Libya ranked first in Africa (53 globally) on the Human Development Index -- ahead of Saudi Arabia at 55, Iran at 70, South Africa at 73, Jordan at 82, Egypt at 101, Indonesia at 108, India at 119, Afghanistan at 155.

(b) Libyans receive free education and health care. (c.) Substantial cash when they marry. (d) Free overseas education if they qualify.

(e) Program to Privatize Oil: On February 21, 2011, five days after the Arab Spring broke out in Libya; Qaddafi launched a new program to privatize all Libyan oil to every citizen of Libya, initially providing \$21,000 to every Libyan from a total of \$32,000,000,000 in the Year 2011.
